model showcases this interior theme, displaying mauve as the main color.


Throughout all these models, Greenberg and her staff interwove antique and contemporary furnishings, the eclectic design hallmark of the award-winning firm.


Wood Construction Creates — A Classic For Our Times

Presenting an old Cape Cod theme in sunny South Florida, Villas of Ocean Dunes is authentic down to its beautiful, durable wood construction.

True to the plans of noted architect Robin Bosco, Miami, the five Villas of Ocean Dunes floor plans feature gabled rooflines, chimneys and blue grey exteriors accented by crisp white trim. Their rustic two and three bedroom, one or two story design accurately depict the charm of the Cape Cod "school of architecture." And, underlying this picturesque charm are the superior qualities of wood construction.

Though concrete block has been the common construction method in Florida for the past 20 years, wood construction is preferable over concrete block for many reasons. Used in the Cape Cod construction for hundreds of years, wood stands the test of time and climate up North where weather and humidity variables are much more dramatic than in Florida.

According to the Washington, D.C. based American Wood Council, wood's internal structure of hollow cells containing millions of tiny air cells makes it 15

times a more effective insulator against heat and cold than stone or concrete. In comparison with aluminum, wood is 1,700 times more effective.

Also, due to its unique cellular makeup, wood does not hold in humidity like concrete block construction. It actually removes humidity from the home. That cellular structure also makes wood more elastic, explaining why wood can bend and stand up better than steel under the stress of high winds or earthquakes. In fact, a wood block, just one inch square and 21/4-inches

long, can support five tons on its end, meaning pound for pound, wood is stronger than steel.

As for sound control, because wood does not carry and magnify sound like concrete, sound control is certainly more efficient.

The dramatic gabled rooflines, fireplaces and wood railinged porches distinguishing the "beach home" look of Villas of Ocean Dunes is also accomplished using wood. Flexible wood construction allows the Villas' builder to keep the home framing, angles and overall design true to the architects' Cape Cod themed plans. From an aesthetic standpoint, wood construction ensures Villas of Ocean Dunes' impressive architectural integrity.

From the rustic cedar siding on the home exteriors to the termite and rot resistant wood used in the homes' joists, studs, trusses and sheathing, the construction methods is a natural for the Villas' ocean-oriented setting.

A classic for our times, Villas of Ocean Dunes homes will surely stand as future classics, as their Northern Cape Cod wood-constructed counterparts have.

Landscape design presents "New England in Spring"

Villas of Ocean Dunes' remarkable site, boasting rolling terrain and sand dunes just 1,200 feet from the Atlantic Ocean, is truly one of the last unspoiled areas of northern Palm Beach County. Preserving this area, while adding a further measure of beauty, the Villas landscape is a perfect complement.

Landscape architect Winston Lee, associated with Urban Design Studio of West Palm Beach, took the Villas' unique site and equally unique architecture into full account. The Cape Cod theme was modified for Florida's climate by using subtropical plantings to evoke a feeling of Cape Cod in the spring.

Developer Lazarus and Jennings, for whom Lee has been associated on its Villas of North Dade and the Club Cottages, Golf Villas and Patio Homes in PGA National Resort, maintained the site's natural dune lines. To Lee, the gently rolling dunes contribute to the interesting, custom look of the neighborhoods and thus should be accented.

At the top of the dunes, clusters of tall palms are the important focal points, while brick paving at the entry drive provides a rustic counterpoint.

There will be a profusion of color throughout the community, ensured by flowers and flowering shrubs both on the common areas and around the residences. Lattice work and trellises will complement the Cape Cod themed residential buildings.

Colorful flowering vines, such as

bougainvillea, will spill over walls, while shade trees such as live oak, black olive, rosewood and mahogany will provide a wooded, cool atmosphere.

Around the lake, the heart of the community, Lee selected Malayan coconut palms as the dominant tree. Resistant to lethal yellowing, these

graceful palms will tower above the lake and reflect beautifully in the rippling water.
