Please place all trash in the appropriate container.

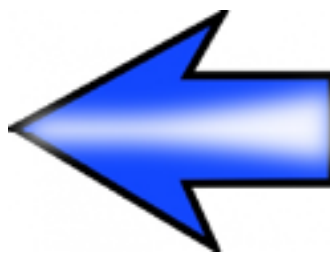
All cardboard boxes should be collapsed before disposing them.

Magic Cookie Bars

Have You Ever Made Magic Cookie Bars? So easy, You Are Going To Love Them!

Course Cookies

Cuisine American

Prep Time 5 minutes

Cook Time 25 minutes

Total Time 30 minutes

Servings 20 bars

Calories 311 kcal

Ingredients

- 3/4 cup butter melted
- 1 package graham crackers crushed
- 1 14 oz can sweetened condensed milk
- 1-2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips depending on your chocolate needs
- 1 1/2 cups coconut shredded
- 1 cup pecans chopped

Instructions

1. Heat oven to 350 degrees..
2. Melt butter and pour into a 9x13 pan.
3. Crush the graham crackers and mix them in the butter in your pan.
4. Pour condensed milk evenly over the crumbs.
5. Layer the remaining ingredients evenly.
6. Bake for 25 minutes or until browned on edges.
7. Cool completely before cutting into squares or bars.
8. Store left-overs in an air-tight container.
